

Sue's Drive Rite 2019 Video Challenge

Submission Form

Rules:

- 1 entry per school. Each school may have multiple entries but can only submit 1 entry for the contest. The schools may choose to hold their own challenge to determine which video to submit.
- If people, photos, or music are included in the video there must be a copyright release submitted with the video (students can also create their own photos/music as long as a release is submitted with the video).

Each video must include the following:

1. Video must be a minimum of 30 seconds and a maximum of 2 minutes in length.
2. Minimum of 2 of the following categories: (can include all 3)
 - a. Distractions
 - b. Speeding
 - c. No restraints

Examples: cell phone, alcohol, not paying attention to road, outside influences, looking at other things/objects, eating, drinking, reading, computers, putting on makeup, speeding, bad weather, traffic conditions, parents, siblings, no restraints...

3. Logo with phone number needs to be on video at bottom right hand corner of the entire video. Sue's Drive Rite will provide the logo.
4. Ten to twenty seconds spent explaining how the situation could have been eliminated entirely (must be within the min/max time constraints).

Example of video:

1. Scenario with minimum of 2 of the above categories with the outcome, with explanation of how to make drivers more aware, and the outcome of the more aware driving.
2. Scenario with 2 distractions and the outcome and explanation of how the outcome could have been prevented.
3. Scenario with minimum of 2 of the above categories with aftermath of a traumatic events. Show how many lives were changed forever and who all was impacted by this event. Then show how it could have been prevented.
